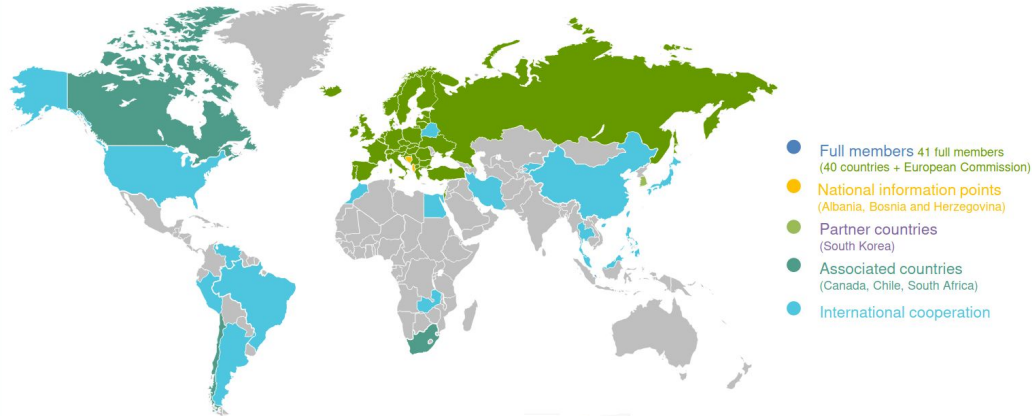

The UK, a supporting country:

- **Up to £5MN** pledge to the current **Eureka Luster Smart Advance Manufacturing Call#6**

Eligibility Criteria (general):

- must follow standard Cluster consortia rules of country representation and 'balanced' budget allocation across partners
- TRL 5-8
- civil applications, not defence

UK Eligibility Criteria:

- must be a UK-based research organisation or business of any size
- to lead a project;
 - *must be a business of any size*
 - *must involve at least one UK-based SME*
- UK lead can also collaborate with other independent UK-based businesses of any size and UK based research organisations
- subcontractors allowed, preferably UK-based, capped at 20% of the total eligible project costs of the UK partners
- research organisations cannot lead on an application, must collaborate with UK-based SME
- research organisations must be able to show how they will exploit the results of the project to grow the wider advanced manufacturing sector in the UK
- can self-fund, cannot lead



EUREKA



Scope Criteria (general):

- support & grow the entire advanced manufacturing value chain
- help the formation of innovation “ecosystems” with the potential of rapid exploitation
- a clear route to commercial markets within 2 to 3 years of project completion

UK Scope Criteria:

- innovation of products and solutions across;
 - *Net Zero and resource efficiency through smart design*
 - *Digitalisation*
 - *Increased Productivity*
 - *Flexible Manufacturing*
 - *Resilience and responsiveness in supply chains*

Innovate UK will **not** consider projects where innovation resides primarily in software

Process:

- **3 Stages.** Project Outline 'PO' (Eureka)*, Full Project Proposal 'FPP' & Smart Label (Eureka), **National Agency assessment for funding (UK, IFS system)** *PO stage not mandatory for FPP submission

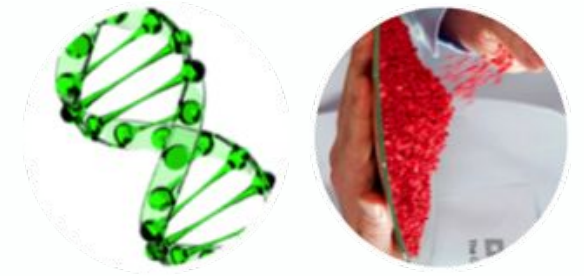

Support for European Programmes

We support UK organisations in **engaging with International R&I initiatives** (i.e. Horizon Europe and EUREKA, among them) and help shape future funding priorities by:

- Managing international collaboration platforms



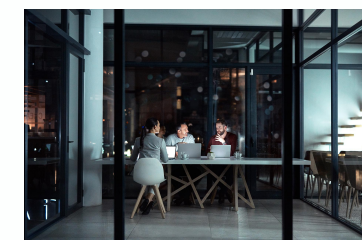
We work closely with the National Contact Points, Innovate UK Edge and the FCDO / Science Innovation Network.

Travel Grants

Innovate UK KTN Travel Grants supports attendance of UK based R&D performing SMEs to specific targeted events for the purpose of increasing engagement with potential partners.

Characteristics:

- Application for each specific event gets advertised @ Innovate UK KTN website together with the respective webinar
- A maximum of £500 can be claimed as a contribution towards travel costs incurred for the purpose of attending the specific event. Only 1 representative per SME.
- Applicants awarded travel support must:
 - register for the event themselves;
 - book and pay for their travel (in advance of the event) and
 - submit their travel claim to the KTN contact advised.
