



Agri-Tech and Food-Tech Launchpad in Eastern England

£7.5m Launchpad Support:

- Collaborative R&D funding £150,000-£300,000
- MFA grants (100%) £25,000-£100,000
- New Innovators (100%) £25,000-£50,000
- Cluster Management Wider Support, Portfolio
 Support & Promotion of Cluster in Eastern England.

Launchpad Aims:

- 1. Engage more businesses in innovation activities
- 2. Develop new collaborative research and development partnerships within the region
- 3. Encourage more high-quality future bids
- 4. Attract people from outside the region

Themes supported through the Launchpad:

- Sustainability in the context of environmental challenges.
- Enhancing productivity of primary crops, the bioeconomy, livestock, aquaculture or ornamental plants.
- Biotechnologies related to agriculture, food and nutrition.

- Resilience in the supply chain.

















Eligibility

- Companies with <u>ambition</u>
- All stages, apart from pre-seed
- Innovation at core, and disrupting markets
- Potential for 20% y-o-y growth
- Up to 250 employees (minimum of two)
- <u>Potential</u> to internationalise
- Ideally with early traction, or MVP
- Leadership open to external support
