
Health Funding Map

What are we looking for?

We are looking for businesses who can demonstrate that their innovation activities have the best potential for future growth

The application will be evaluated on:

- the quality of your project
- our judgement on the suitability of the business to receive a loan

We look for applications that show:

- an appropriate and evidenced borrowing proposal from a suitable business
- a high quality later-stage R&D project
- a clear route to commercial success
- a strong management team
- why there is a need for additional public funding in order to be able to carry out your project
- why the applicant is unable to fund the project from their resources or other forms of private-sector funding


Launchpads

Macro Objectives

Key Mission Directive: To fortify and amplify the capability and widen the horizons of opportunities for a number of key identified clusters and the associated sector specialisms.

To identify and grant support the pivotal programmes that will deliver the core impact metrics that are *co-created with the regional Partners*

Metrics including safeguarded jobs, additional jobs, new businesses being set up or migrating into the region, new and strengthened links between the regional businesses and RTOs

> To convene a future pathway of opportunity for the clusters that include the practitioners within the cluster alongside the inward national and international investors networks

14 projects across digital health, biotech therapeutics and diagnostics and medical technologies disciplines = 2 collaborative R&D projects and 12 projects solely for SMEs


Health technologies in West Yorkshire

Dedicated to the advancement of healthcare solutions and medical breakthroughs

Partner: West Yorkshire Combined Authority

10 projects for this cluster = 2 collaborative R&D projects and 8 solely for SMEs. 4 of the projects are centred on the use of AI and data within healthcare.
